On Mission – In last Sunday's sermon, I gave a challenge to our church to be on mission. I have spoken to the Council of Deacons about this need in our body. We do an excellent job of praying for and giving to missions, but I feel God calling us to be more engaged in going out to do missions. In that regard, I have proposed four mission possibilities for us to consider.

Of course, going on mission means that we must deny ourselves, take up our crosses, and follow Jesus to serve others self-sacrificially in His name. We must make going on mission a priority in our schedules, plans, and personal budgets.

Below are the On-Mission opportunities that I have presented to our deacons. God is calling us to go out on mission with Him. With which of these possibilities is God touching your heart? We can pick one or more, but we need to begin. Would you be willing to make the sacrifice to go on mission? If you are interested and feel God calling you to one of these mission efforts, please let me know so that we can pray and explore together the way God may be opening for us to go together on mission with Him.

- Alderson Ministerial Association in Alderson, WV Our On-Mission Team will work on home repair projects (e.g., handicapped ramps, roof repairs, etc.) and possibly support local VBS ministry. Cost is estimated to be about \$300 per person which would cover transportation, housing, meals, and materials for a five-day trip.
- Belize Our On-Mission Team will travel to Punta Gorda, Belize to work with Victor Hernandez at Toledo Faith Outreach Christian Center (TFOCC). Possible ministries include conducting VBS in remote villages and at the center. Weeks for travel this year are July 6-13, July 13-20, July 27-August 3. The overall cost is estimated to be about \$1,600 per person. Other churches from Lebanon Baptist Association are planning to go, and we may be able to join with these teams.
- France Our On-Mission Team will work with a SBC missionary couple whose ministry is focused on Muslims living in inner-city Paris. There is also the possibility of ministry in Marseille distributing Bibles and talking with Muslims as the depart to or arrive from North Africa. The cost for this trip is estimated to be around \$2,500 per person.
- Brazil Our On-Mission Team will work with Rick & Jill Thompson, who are home folks for us. Jill is the namesake of our Audrey and Jill Circle. Rick & Jill regularly host teams from the US to do evangelism, discipleship, and prayer walking. The cost of this trip would be about \$1,700 per person.

Don is a retired BGAV pastor who last served as pastor of First Baptist Church of Alexandria. He previously served as president of the Baptist General Association of Virginia, was a trustee for New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and served on the boards of both Hopetree Family Services of Virginia and Guidestone Financial Resources. Don will bring the sermon that God has laid on his heart for our congregation.


